The OACTA Law Student Inclusion & Equity scholarship program is open to incoming second and third year law students who are enrolled in an Ohio law school or are permanent Ohio residents including, but not limited to, minority law students; LGBTQIA+ law students regardless of race or ethnicity; female law students, regardless of race or ethnicity; law students with disabilities, regardless of race or ethnicity; law students from economically impoverished families/backgrounds, regardless of race or ethnicity; and law students from geographically disadvantaged communities, regardless of race or ethnicity. The criteria include academic achievements; service to the community and to the cause of inclusion and equity; and experience or interest in a civil defense practice.
