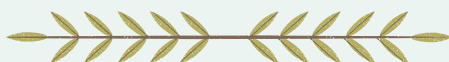


Who can be a Mentor?

Eligible attorneys have been admitted to practice law in Ohio for at least 5 years; have never been subjected to disciplinary action; are registered active; are in good standing; have been a member of OACTA for at least two years.

Who can be a Mentee?

Eligible attorneys have been admitted to practice law in Ohio for less than 5 years; have never been subjected to disciplinary action; are registered active; are in good standing; are a member of OACTA.
